## DEFINITION OF A TRANSFER STUDENT

Anyone who has graduated from high school and enrolled in college for a long semester—fall or spring. Summer school classes do not count.

All VETERANS or members of the military. A military transcript will transfer as 4 hours PE credit for basic military training. TCU participates in the Yellow Ribbon program.

## TRANSFER HOURS

A Student with less than 24 transferable hours can transfer, but will be evaluated on both college and high school transcripts as well as SAT/ACT scores.

## TRANSFER CREDIT

Most college level courses with a grade of “C” or better will transfer from a regionally accredited university or community college. See back cover for transferrable core credit classes. Other classes may transfer as elective credit or fulfill major requirements as determined by academic deans.

## ADMISSION GPA

The typical student has about a 2.7 or higher GPA. Neeley School of Business pre-majors require a 3.0 GPA from a four-year college, or a 3.25 GPA from a two-year college. Given the extremely competitive nature of medical school admission, (e.g., an average entering GPA in excess of 3.7 at most medical schools), transfer students must meet or exceed specific GPA requirements to be accepted into TCU's Pre-Health Professions Program. ## DEADLINES

- March 15 - Fall Early Notification
- April 15 - Fall Scholarship and Financial Aid
- August 1 - Fall Final Deadline
- October 1 - Spring Financial Aid (Scholarships not guaranteed)
- December 1 - Spring Final Deadline

## NURSING CLINICAL DEADLINES

- November 15 - Summer Accelerated Nursing (Prior Bachelor's degree required)
- February 1 - Fall Regular Nursing

## HOUSING REQUIREMENTS

Students entering TCU as a Transfer student who have been out of high school for less than two years will be required to live on-campus, as space is available. TCU Housing & Residence Life will waive the residency requirement for Transfer students after August 1 if beds are not available. Therefore, campus housing cannot be guaranteed to any TCU Transfer student.

## TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

- Minimum GPA 3.25 and 27 transferrable credit hours, by June 1 for Fall Semester, October 1 for Spring Semester
- Deans - \$15,000 for 3 years
- Faculty - \$11,000 for 3 years
- Phi Theta Kappa - (TCU Sponsored) - \$8,500 for 3 years
- TCU Scholarship - \$8,000 for 3 years
